

# HEADLICE ALERT!

If headlice break out in your area the priority is to protect as best as possible the people not yet infested, by halting the spread of parasites by effective treatment!



## How to get rid of headlice & nits in 6 EASY STEPS:

- 1 Treat the infested person immediately with suitable, and if possible, non-toxic anti-lice agents. Consult your GP or pharmacist if you have any concerns.
- 2 Lice are common and easily spread! Immediately inform family, nursery, school, close contacts & friends of the infested person.
- 3 Check others for nits and lice with an inspection comb. Treat them if required, ideally with a non-toxic anti-lice agent.
- 4 Although transfer through non person to person contact is rare, you might want to take the precaution and wash fabrics such as bedding and clothes at no less than 60°C (check washing instructions).
- 5 After treatment continue regularly check infested people with a nit comb.
- 6 Nit Nurse is the natural non-toxic solution to nitty outbreaks.
